Students lack exposure to science and technology, limiting their future opportunities. Hands-on experiments and interactive learning experiences are crucial for fostering curiosity and technical skills.




### 5. Motivation and Goal Setting:

### **2. Promote Holistic Well-being:**


To improve the overall well-being of students through yoga and mindfulness sessions.


